It's summer — time to soak in the sunshine, go on adventures, and recharge! But before you know it, **August and September will be here**, and with them comes a fresh new year of Scouting. Let's make sure your unit is prepped and ready for a strong fall start.

Here is your **Fall Recruitment Prep Checklist:**

Leader Readiness

- Identify your Lion and Tiger Den Leaders early.
- Make sure all leaders have completed Youth Protection Training (YPT) and position-specific training on my.Scouting.org.
- Consider creating a short “meet your leaders” flyer or slideshow with names, bios, and contact info to help new families feel connected right away.

Plan Your Recruitment Strategy

- Host a unit planning meeting with parents and adults over the summer to finalize your calendar, budget, and recruitment plan.
- Schedule your Join Scouting Night (JSN) for a weekday (Tues-Thurs) before Friday, September 19, 2025.
- Ask your local school if you can set up a Scouting table at their Open House — and remember, the Council can help with flyers and materials.
- Build a simple unit calendar and budget to hand out at your JSN — families love knowing what to expect.

Register and Promote

- **Promote “Camp Miakonda Adventure Day” on Saturday, September 20, 2025** — it's a great hook for families thinking about joining!
- Submit all new applications to the Council office **by Monday, September 29, 2025**.
- Use social media, email, and Scoutbook announcements to spread the word and invite friends.

Safety Moment: Navigating Incidents

This guide serves as a roadmap, outlining the steps to take when faced with an incident while prioritizing safety and appropriate action.

- Step 1: Immediate Safety
- Step 2: Grasp the Full Situation
- Step 3: Document the Incident Thoroughly
- Step 4: Notify the Local Council
- Step 5: Follow Up with Care

When unexpected incidents occur in Scouting, swift and accurate reporting is essential to safeguard the safety and well-being of everyone involved. As a Unit, your responsibility is to promptly notify your Council of any incident with clear, concise, and accurate details regarding the incident.
