Safety Moment: Gaga Ball

Gaga Ball is a fast-paced sport that has become very popular in the US. The game is played in an octagonal pit and is considered by many to be a gentler version of dodgeball.

A few safety tips:

- Players must play others similar in age.
- Always have adult supervision, aligned with Scouting America policies, to monitor this activity.
- Don't use hard balls. Use foam or other soft materials.
- Encourage youth to hit the ball with an open hand versus a closed fist.
- Explain and play by the rules.

If executed correctly, Gaga Ball is a fun and safe activity providing youth with hours of entertainment and exercise.
